

The students have 10+ hours of Spanish lessons that we can do while visiting places or in the conference room in the hotel. The Spanish programme is adapted to the level of the students.

Throughout the programme, students spend their time in Spain with their native Spanish teachers and tour guides, gaining natural exposure to the language through everyday conversations with natives, Spanish cultural trips and social outings.

PRACTISE SPANISH IN REAL LIFE!

This Spanish Hotel Immersion Programme focuses on the **four core skills** of language (reading, writing, listening, and speaking), as well as pronunciation and intonation. However, speaking and listening will be our main goals.

The entire purpose of your week with us will be to help you gain confidence. You will almost certainly agree with us when we say that speaking and listening in Spanish is a challenge for almost every student. In fact, many people avoid public speaking merely because they lack confidence.

Our SHIP will change everything! We have created a programme that will gradually help you expand your comfort zone so that by the end of the week, you'll feel more at ease speaking to native speakers.

You can come alone or travel with loved ones, even if they are not interested in the academic programme. We have different programmes to suit everyone's needs.



What the academic programme includes:

- One initial introduction session online with your Spanish teacher, discussing your results from the level test, and preparations for the trip before departure
- 10+ hours' group lessons + endless hours of conversations (in Spanish, of course)
- Study materials
- Comprehensive end-of-course report
- Attendance certificate
- A surprise present or maybe more than one ;-)

Who is this programme recommended for?

Students above the age of 18 are eligible for the Adult SHIP. Under 18s are also welcome as long as they come with their parents/relatives/guardians.

Cádiz province



Cadiz province has some of Andalucia's most windswept beaches, prettiest white villages, and the most celebrated Spanish wine: Sherry.

Its coastline has long been peppered with fishing ports that were established by the Phoenicians, Greeks and Romans. Today, the Cadiz coast is a mecca for windsurfers, birdwatchers, and anyone who prefers a wilder shoreline with relatively few beachgoers, compared to the busier Costa del Sol.

Algeciras

Its location, on the eastern end of the Algeciras Bay, across from Gibraltar, has made it one of the most important ports in Europe, for both passengers and merchandise.

The oldest area of the city, with narrow, steep streets, is the district of San Isidro. Among the most interesting monuments we have the church of Nuestra Señora de la Palma, from the 18th century, and the chapel of Nuestra Señora de Europa, from the 17th century. It also has excellent beaches, like Rinconcillo, San García, and Getares, although a good section of its 23-kilometre-long coastline is devoted to industrial development, due to its long seafaring tradition.

Paco de Lucía tour



We will tour the hometown of the artist "PACO DE LUCÍA" in search of all the corners that inspired the master for the creation of most of his works. It is worth mentioning his birthplace, the food market, full of aromas and flavors of our land, and the high square with its peculiarities among many other places in town. At the same time we will be immersed in a historical Algeciras where we will travel back in time to learn about the different civilizations that passed through our land.

The mixture of culture that occurred over time and that today is reflected in a modern Algeciras will surprise you. Not only will we enjoy explanations, visits to monuments and ruins of the ancient city, during the tour we will do some fun activities with which we will learn about the rhythms that move our parties in the Flamenco area.

Bolonia and Tarifa



The perfect place to immerse ourselves in a mixture of nature and culture. We will visit the ancient city of Baelo Clauida (archaeological site) at the foot of the beach of Bolonia with its impressive dunes and views of the vast Atlantic Ocean. We will continue our way to the town of Tarifa where we will continue to be amazed by its nature, history, and of course its gastronomy. It is noteworthy that at this point we will visit the island of pigeons, which apart from being the southernmost point of the peninsula, is where the waters of the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean mix with each Cartographically we can say that it is the boundary between two waters. We cannot forget the incredible views of the African continent that is so close.

Castellar and Jimena



Ceuta

To speak of Ceuta is to speak of Ulysses, is to speak of Hercules (heroes of Greek mythology) the architect of the separation of Africa and Europe. In short, Ceuta is a land of myths and legends, which you will see when you visit it.

In this city you are going to know through its viewpoints and its barracks the military history of SPAIN and the relationship that exists, from the strategic-military point of view, with GIBRALTAR. You will discover in a walk through time, all the civilizations that have left their mark on the city (AFRICAN GATEWAY AND ROYAL WALLS, TARDORROMAN BASILICA) and many more things that will undoubtedly surprise you.

Gibraltar

A little piece of the United Kingdom, riched by the Cádiz province, in the form of a limestone rock about 426m-high. Have you heard of the monkeys that inhabit the rock of Gibraltar? Who knows if they surprise us during some of our explanations and stops on the tour.

Gibraltar is a British Overseas Territory and a headland on the south coast of Spain. The Rock of Gibraltar, a 426m-high limestone ridge, dominates the landscape. The outpost was first settled by the Moors in the Middle Ages and later ruled by Spain before being ceded to the British in 1713. Fortifications include the ruins of a 14th-century Moorish castle and the Great Siege Tunnels, which were expanded during WWII.
